#### Torquay, The Great Ocean Road, Apollo Bay, 12 Apostles, Loch Ard Gorge

The iconic Great Ocean Road is next as your coach winds its way along one of the world's most iconic and picturesque ocean lined roads. It's time to say goodbye to The Grampians as we make our way to the large historic town of Ballarat.

#### **Ballarat, The Art Gallery Ballarat**
